SPEECH OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE AII, Amb. Giovanni Castellaneta

- Dear President, Prime Ministers, Excellencies...
- I would like to thank you for the outstanding organization of this high level event and for the choice of the topic that is also on the top of the Adriatic and Ionian Initiative and EUSAIR Agenda: *Building Security, Boosting Economy, Enabling Prosperity*;
